other: bombs, hand grenades, Molotov cocktails, poison and poisonous gas, vehicle and arson attacks

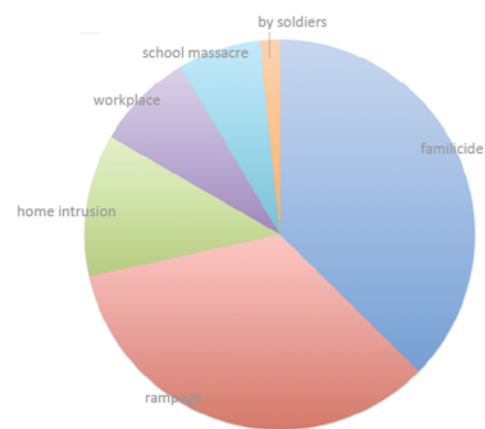
melee: knives, swords, spears, machetes, axes, clubs, rods, stones, or bare hands

firearms/melee

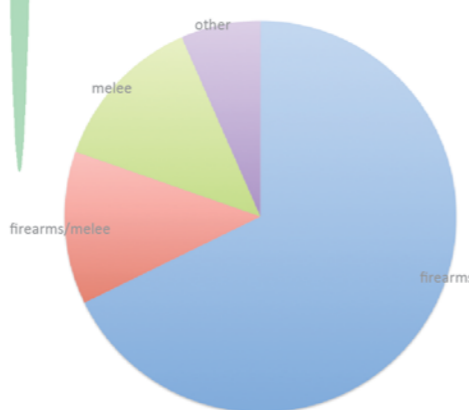
firearms: rifles and handguns, bows and crossbows, grenade launchers, flamethrowers, or slingshots

injured

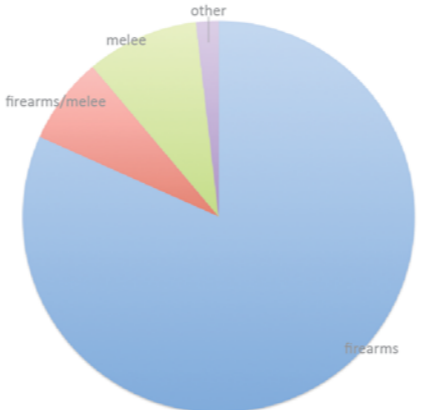
mass murder: four or more murders occurring during a particular event with no cooling-off period between the murders

workplace: disgruntled workers, predominantly targeted (former) co-workers



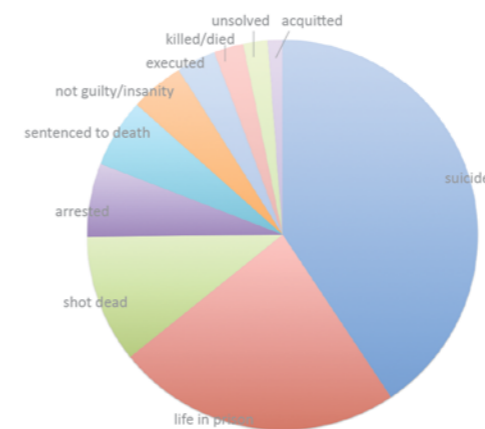
incident, by type



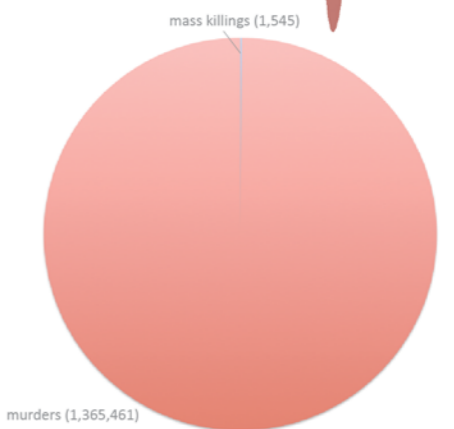
dead, by weapon
